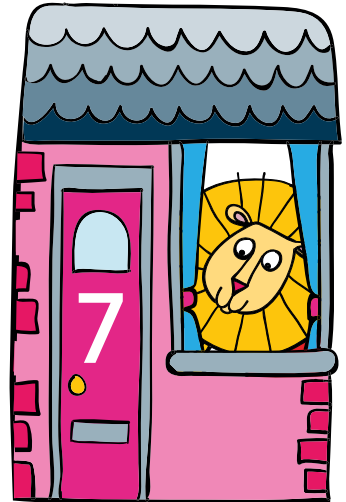
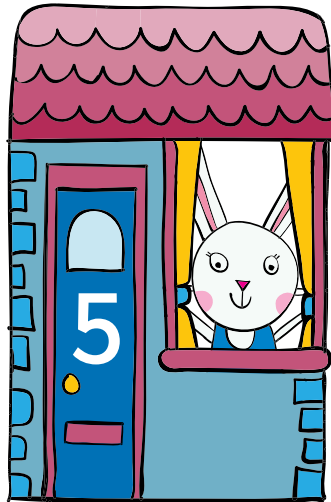
# Postman Monkey



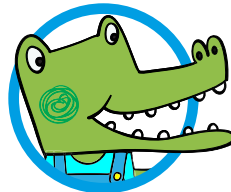
Monkey is practising his numbers so he can write them on some envelopes. Draw over the numbers with him.

## Grown-ups' notes

Recognising numbers is one of the most important introductions to pre-school maths. Read the numbers at the top out loud together and then ask your child to say the numbers as they draw over them.

- Go on a number hunt and encourage your child to spot numbers all around them on houses, buses, cars, remote controls etc...
- Stick numbers to toy cars and write the same numbers on bits of paper. Ask your child to park the cars on the right paper spaces.
- Write the numbers 1-6 in an egg box carton and help them fill each section with the right number of raisins.
