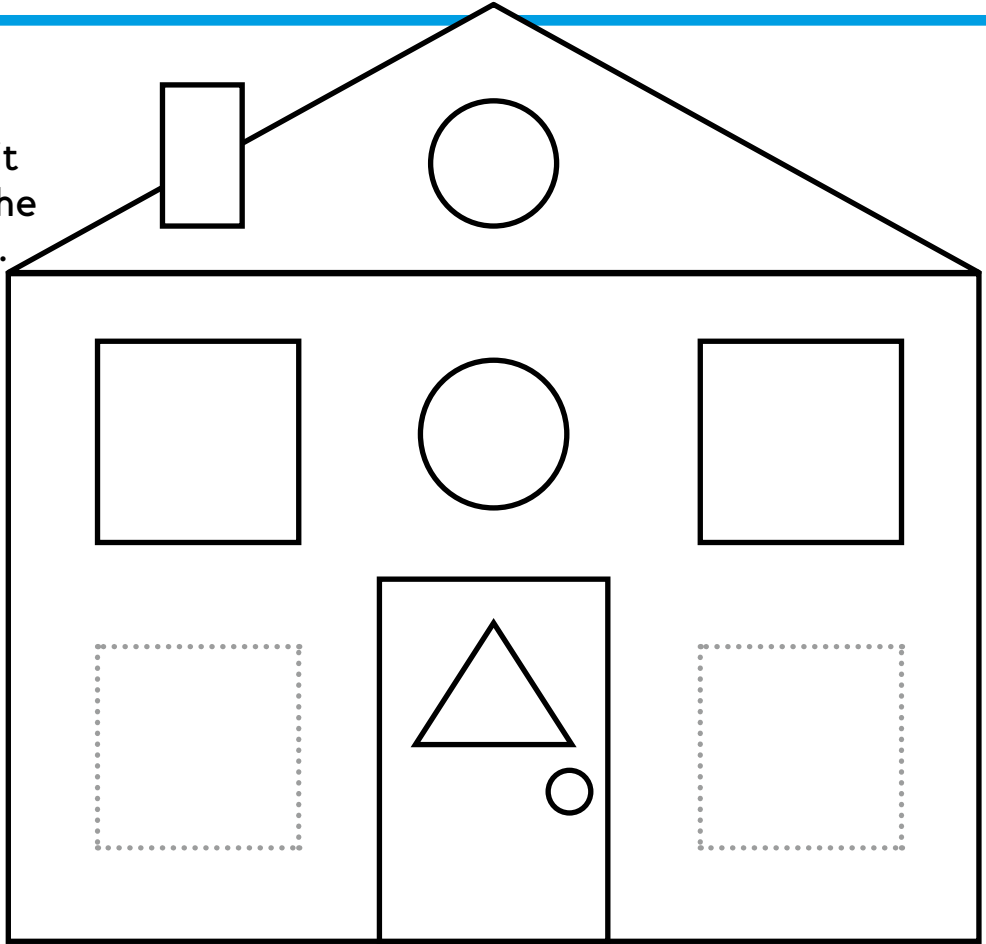






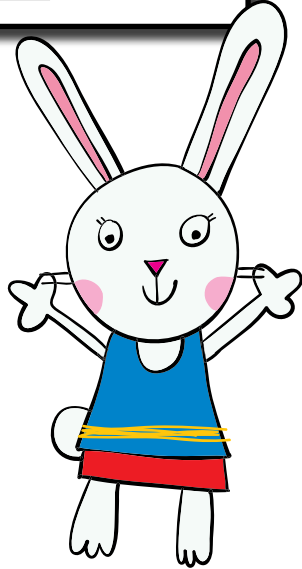
Super shapes!

Look, this house is made from lots of shapes. Help Rabbit colour it in using the colour code below.

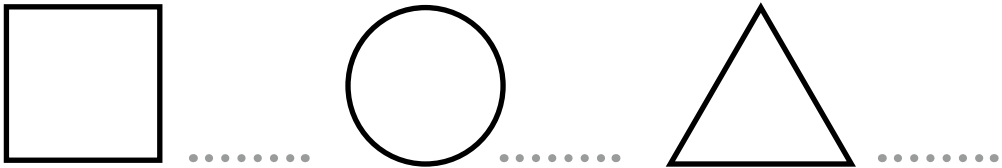

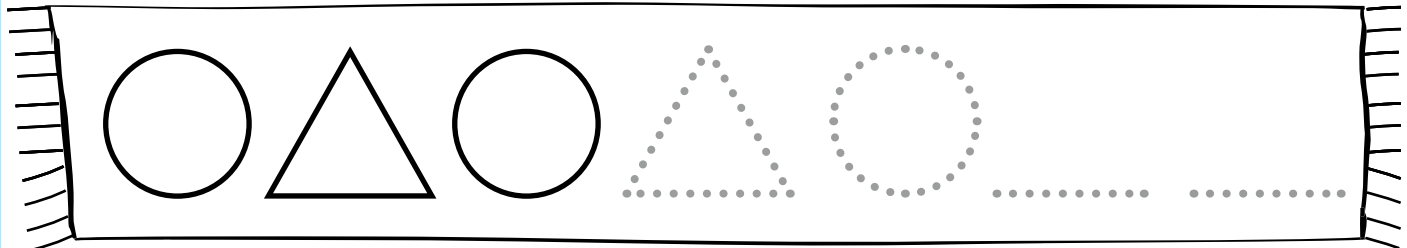
-  = Yellow

Grown-ups' notes

Learning about shapes and patterns helps children make sense of the world around them, recognising order and 'what comes next.' See how many shapes your child recognises on the house and get them to match them up to the shapes on the colour code.

- Draw each of the shapes on a piece of paper and go on a walk to see if your child can spot anything the same shape.
- Play 'I spy' but with shapes. 'I spy with my little eye something shaped like a circle...'
- Create patterns – make up short dances, or rhythms using your body (e.g. clap, clap, stomp, belly tap, and repeat).
